What data do we collect?

Our Company may collect the following data:

- Personal identification information such as: Name, email address, phone number,
- Business identification infrormation such as: Business name, email address, phone numbers, payment information.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Our Company with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or place an order for any of our services or products.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.
- Contact us by email and provide your contact details in the email you sent.

Our Company may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

• By proxy, via an email that was sent to us and and your details were copied in via 'CC'.

How will we use your data?

Our Company collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order, manage your account.
- Email you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.
- General communicatons with you through messaging systems, meetings and calls.

When Our Company processes your order, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

Our Company securely stores your data at:

Our Company may also keep your data which has been entered into forms on our website, in our website database servers located in a secure enclave of Amazon Website Services located at a datacentre in the Rublic of Ireland or the UK Mainland for a period of up to 2 years generally, or up to 7 years for legal / tax auditing. Once this time period has expired, we will review the and securely delete your data in line with General Data Protection Register (GDPR) policy guidance.

Marketing

If you have agreed to receive marketing by opting in, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop Our Company from contacting you for marketing purposes.

If you no longer wish to be contacted for marketing purposes, contact us using the contact details listed in this document.

What are your data protection rights?

Our Company would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights.

Every user is entitled to the following:

- The right to access You have the right to request Our Company for copies of your personal data.
- The right to rectification You have the right to request that Our Company correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Our Company to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- The right to erasure You have the right to request that Our Company erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to restrict processing You have the right to request that Our Company restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to object to processing You have the right to object to Our Company's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to data portability You have the right to request that Our Company transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
